


LEADS CRICKET S BATTLE






amongst the characters while Adnan Abdul Hafeez described the struggle of the people against tyranny of the rulers.

PhD programs for candidates having CGPA less than 3, Appointment of Meritorious Professors as External Experts for evaluation of PhD scholars etc.



He highlighted the policy's role in promoting research, innovation, and academic excellence. He shared the main features of GEP 2023 with the audience. Dr. Ejaz Ahmad also addressed queries from the audience, fostering an interactive and engaging session. Outcome of this presentation and discussions is summed up in the following paragraphs.

1. Dr. Ejaz Ahmad explained the philosophy behind intra-disciplinary qualification and informed that Intra-disciplinary refers to sub-disciplines occurring within one of the ten broad disciplines defined by UNESCO's International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-F-2013). The intra-disciplinary admission to MS/MPhil and PhD programs may only be allowed if the candidate fulfills certain requirements. He explained these requirements.







- 2. The MS/MPhil degree shall be awarded not before the completion of 1.5 years, and prior to admission into a PhD program, the student shall have been awarded MS/MPhil or equivalent degree, he noted.
- 3. For admission in PhD programs, a minimum CGPA of 3.0 (out of 4.0) is required, however the students having CGPA below 3.00 (out of 4.0) may be admitted to a PhD program after fulfilling certain requirements. He went through these requirements in detail.
- 4. Dr. Ejaz Ahmad further explained that the University is required to conduct admission tests for
- a. admission to MS/MPhil/Equivalent programs, with a passing score of 50% or accept the GRE/HAT General/Equivalent tests, with a passing score of 50%;
- b. admission to PhD programs to conduct the test equivalent to GRE/HAT General with the passing score of 60% or accept a test equivalent to GRE/HAT General, conducted by testing bodies accredited by HEC, with a passing score of 60%
- 5. Referring to external evaluation of PhD dissertation, Dr. Ejaz shared with the audience that the GEP-2023 allows external evaluation by Pakistan-based Distinguished National Professors, Meritorious Professors from any national university; or professors from top universities ranked by HEC; or professors from any Pakistani University having a minimum H-Index 30 for Sciences, 15 for Social Sciences or 8 for Art & Humanities as determined by Web of Science.
- 6. One of the requirements to be a PhD research supervisor as given in GEP-2023 is "A regular/adjunct faculty member or researcher at a public or private university . . .". A debate emerged at this point about what does adjunct faculty mean? Dr. Nadeem Ahmad Bhatti shared the dictionary meaning of the phrase "adjunct faculty" and referred to GEP 2023 which states

"Adjunct Faculty: A contractual faculty member, temporary or part-time, hired outside their fulltime profession such as researchers and scientists at any R&D or public/private sector organization, by educational institutions, typically colleges or universities, to teach specific courses or provide instructional support."

Due to time constraints, some portions of the presentation were not covered in detail. Dr. Muhammad Ehsan Malik proposed that the emphasis should be given to those aspects of the policy that are either new or are modification over previous policy. Dr. Mohammad Nawaz, Director Academics, assured the audience that the remaining topics would be addressed in a follow-up session to be conducted soon.

Dr. Sehrish Khan (Director, Quality Enhancement Cell) thanked the coordination team, comprising Dr. Haseeb Ahmed (Deputy Director, Directorate of Academics), Mr. Saeed Zubair (Assistant Director, Directorate of Academics), and herself for smooth execution of the event. She invited the chief guest Dr. Nadeem Ahmad Bhatti, the Vice Chancellor for his comments.

Dr. Nadeem Ahmad Bhatti appreciated the lively spirit prevailed during the seminar. "I felt like sitting in a classroom" he said. He stressed upon need to understand the philosophy behind GEP- 2023. This policy empowers the universities and HEIs in academic matters and now the responsibility of producing quality research and graduates lies on the shoulders of HEIs. The policy encompasses measures like intra-disciplinary qualification, 1.5 years' duration for MS/MPhil programs, external evaluation of PhD theses by Pakistani scholars, and supervision by adjunct faculty. If implemented wisely, GEP-2023 is capable of addressing several constraints presently existing in the system.

Dr. Saeed Ahmad Watto concluded the event by summarizing the key takeaways and expressing gratitude to the chief guest, resource person, coordination team, and participants for their active involvement. He reaffirmed the University's commitment to implementing the HEC Graduate Education Policy (GEP), 2023, in its academic framework

The event concluded with light refreshment for the participants.
